

Cleaning your Sapling Synchronized Clocks

While many systems in a facility require routine maintenance in order to run efficiently over long periods of time, Sapling Synchronized Clock Systems are designed to work for many years without any maintenance. After the initial setup and installation, there's no need to worry about adjusting the time or altering the clocks in any way. While routine maintenance is not required, some customers like to make sure that their clocks are kept clean and dust free.

For those customers that would like to clean the clocks, we recommend the following steps:

- Use a mild cleaning agent or soft detergent with no grains.
- Lightly soak a towel or cloth and apply gently. Do not spray cleaning agent directly onto the clock, as this may damage the clock.
- Do not use excessive amount of detergent, as it is important to keep liquid from getting into the clock.
- Start with cleaning one clock and check to make sure the crystal or display and the clock case has not been discolored or scratched.
- After making sure that one clock was not damaged in any way by using the detergent, proceed applying it to all other clocks in the system.
